

CONFLICT OF INTEREST CODE FOR THE  
BEACH EROSION AUTHORITY FOR CLEAN OCEANS AND NOURISHMENT  
(BEACON)

The Political Reform Act, Government Code Section 81000, et seq., requires state and local government agencies to adopt and promulgate conflict of interest codes. The Fair Political Practices Commission has adopted a regulation, 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730, which contains the terms of a standard conflict of interest code. It can be incorporated by reference, and may be amended by the Fair Political Practices Commission after public notice and hearings to conform to amendments in the Political Reform Act. Therefore, the terms of 2 Cal. Code of Regs. Section 18730 and any amendments to it duly adopted by the Fair Political Practices Commission are hereby incorporated by reference and, along with the attached Appendices in which members and employees are designated and disclosure categories are set forth, constitute the conflict of interest of BEACON.

Designated employees shall file their statements with BEACON, who will make the statements available for public inspection and reproduction. (Gov. Code Section 81008.) Statements for all designated employees will be retained by BEACON.

APPENDIX A

Designated Positions

The following positions are NOT covered by the code because they must file under section 872000 and therefore, are listed for information purposes only:

Ventura County Treasurer  
Ventura County Auditor-Controller

An individual holding one of the above listed positions may contact the Fair Political Practices Commission for assistance or written advice regarding their filing obligations if they believe that their position has been categorized incorrectly. The Fair Political Practices Commission makes the final determination whether a position is covered by section 87200.

Members BEACON Board and their alternates	1, 2, 3 and 4
Executive Director, Santa Barbara County Counsel	1, 2, 3 and 4
Consultants**	1, 2, 3 and 4 (see below)

\*\*Consultants shall be included in the list of designated employees and shall disclose pursuant to the broadest category in the code subject to the following limitation:

The Executive Director may determine in writing that a particular consultant, although a "designated position" is hired to perform a range of duties that is limited in scope and thus is not required to comply fully with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such determination shall include a description of the consultant's duties and, based upon that description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. The Executive Director's determination is a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this conflict of interest code.

## APPENDIX B

### Disclosure Categories

#### CATEGORY 1

All interests in real property located in the jurisdiction, including any leasehold, beneficial or ownership interest or option to acquire such interest in real property.

#### CATEGORY 2

Investments, business positions and income, including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources which contract or subcontract with BEACON to provide leased facilities, goods, equipment, vehicles, machinery or services of the type utilized by BEACON.

#### CATEGORY 3

Investments, business positions and income, including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources engaged in the appraisal, acquisition or disposal of, real property within the jurisdiction.

#### CATEGORY 4

Investments, business positions and income, including gifts, loans and travel payments, from sources that are subject to the regulatory, permit or licensing authority of, or have an application for a license or permit pending before BEACON and the designated employee's duties involve the supervision or regulation (including but not limited to the issuance or granting of franchises, building permits or other use or business permits or any other land use control or regulation) of that type of business entity or source of income.
